

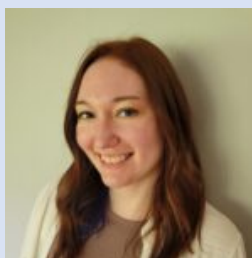


## Cornell Center for Materials Research
